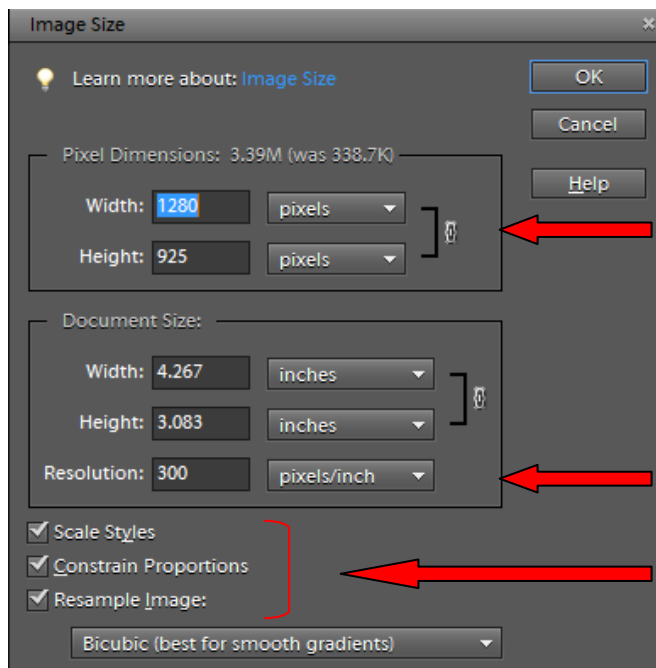


## RESIZING INSTRUCTIONS -- BHPC SLIDE COMPETITION

Open your image-editing program and select the image you want to resize. Make sure you have saved the original image in the format you want i.e. RAW, TIFF, JPEG, etc before you do a resize. Make a duplicate image by going to 'File>Duplicate'. Rename the file and select OK. The Duplicate is the one you will resize.

Go to 'Image>Resize>Image Size'

1. Check on the boxes below that you have available. Most important is "Constrain Proportions" which will allow it to automatically pre-fill the correct Width or Height dimension for the opposite side of your image.
2. Type 300 pixels/inch in the Resolution box.
3. Type 1280 pixels in the Pixel Dimension Width or Height box (whichever is the greater dimension for your image).

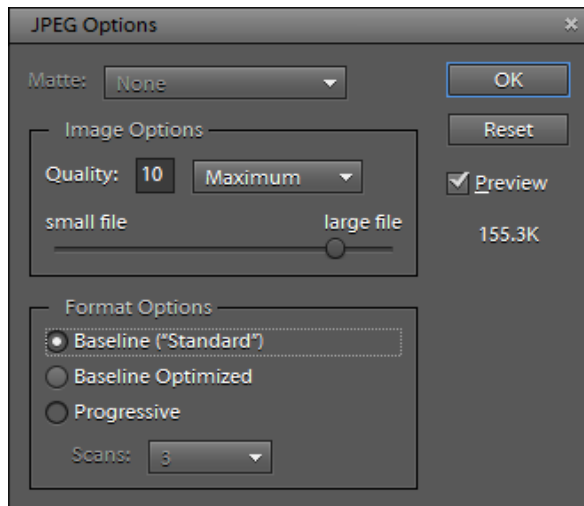


Step 3: On the largest side of your image type in 1280, it will then prefill the correct dimension for the opposite side

Step 2: Type 300 pixels/inch in the Resolution box

Step 1: Select all of these that you may have

When you are done editing your image, save your image. The following “JPEG Options” screen will pop up. Under Image Options select the “Maximum” Quality and click OK.



These instructions are for Photoshop/Photoshop Elements. This should be the same principle in different image-editing programs.
